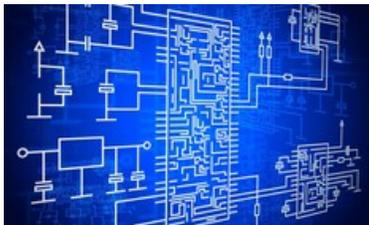


DoD supply chain to be protected under cybersecurity program

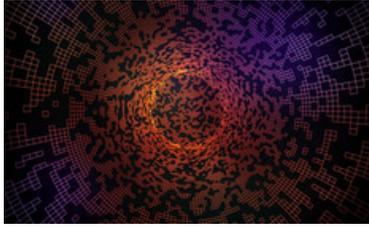


Secure digital operations for U.S. Air Force enabled with D2iQ Kubernetes distribution

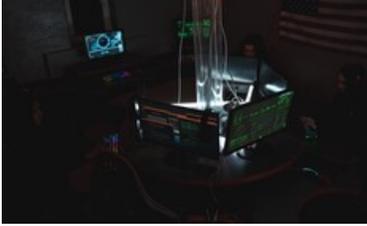
